as Far Apart as Possible



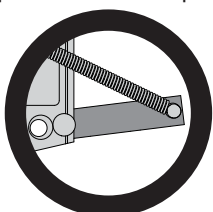
2 PROPER MOUNTING HEIGHT



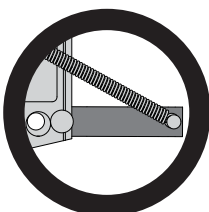
Handle should never

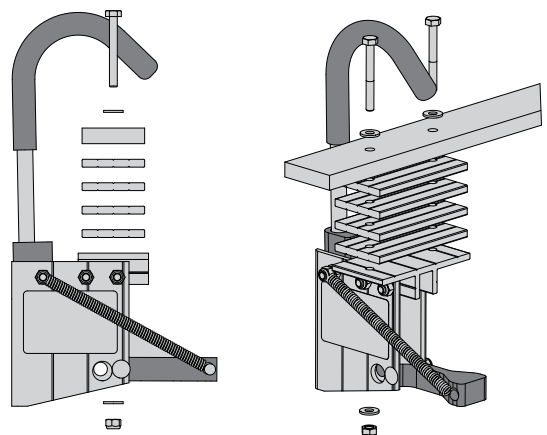
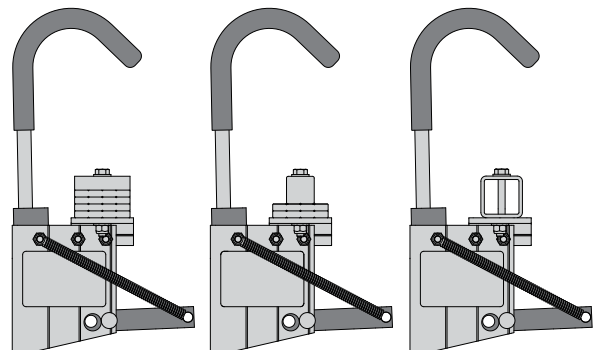

to adjust height.



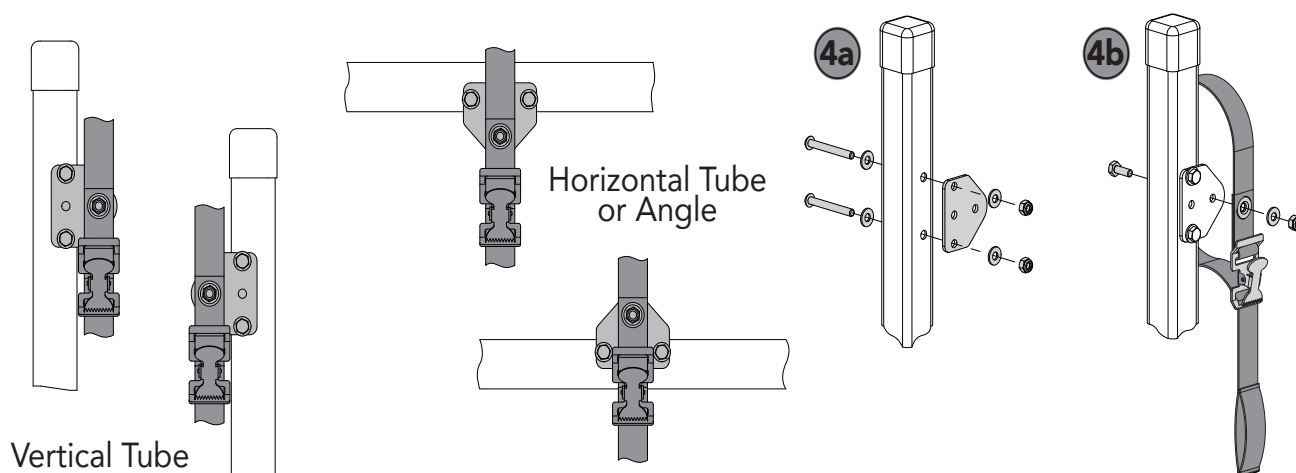
CAUTION

it pulls slightly down on rung of ladder.

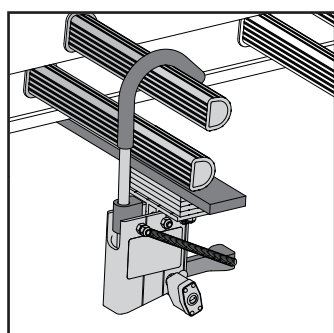
You may need all spacers or

4 STRAP MOUNTING

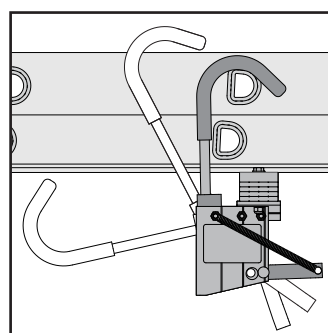


5 PROPER USE OF LADDER CLAMP

FITS EXTENSION LADDER RUNGS

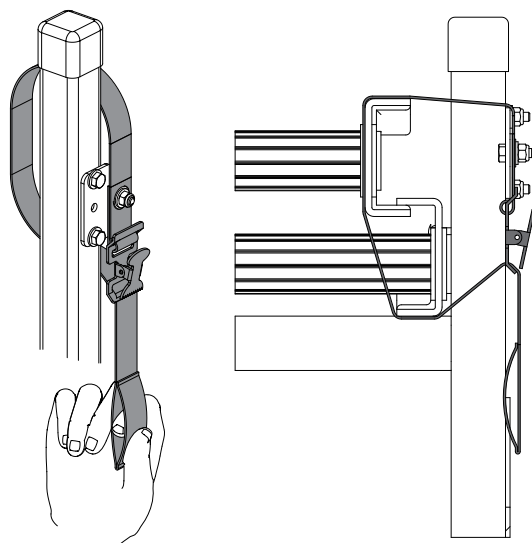


Hook should freely swing up and wrap around extension ladder rung.

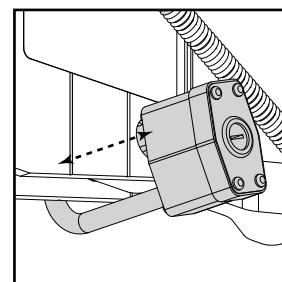


6 PROPER USE OF STRAP

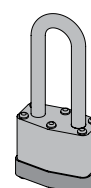
Use Finger Loop and Pull Tight!

EXTEND ALL THE WAY THROUGH



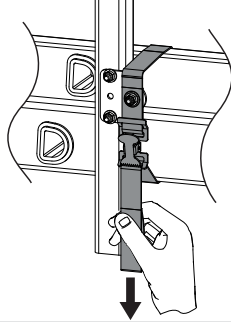
Long Shank Padlock Required



BEFORE DRIVING

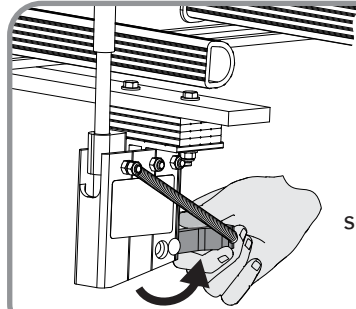
Tighten Strap

Check Clamp

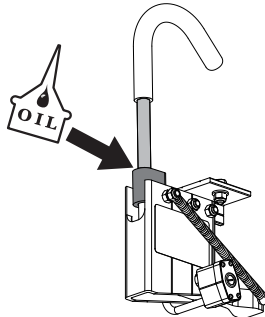
Make sure clamp is secured around ladder properly before operating vehicle.



MAINTENANCE

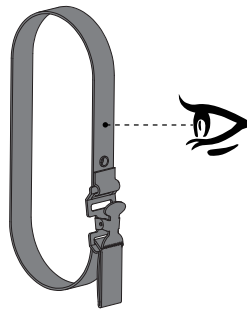
Oil Hook

Check operation weekly, if necessary, add a drop of non-detergent oil.



Check Strap Weekly

Check strap weekly, if necessary, replace with new strap.
